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#### NoVA FSS History

Mission: To bring the community together to create safer streets for people to walk and bike

- Alexandria FSS started in 2017:
  - ~ 900 names email list
  - A VZ Coalition Partner with City's TE&S, Marketing Partner with APD on VZ
  - Alexandria Public Schools to SRTS
    - ~1,200 Middle School students



- **Arlington FSS started in 2019** 
  - ~280 names on email list
  - Advocating for Vision Zero in Arlington County
  - Arlington Public Schools for SRTS
    - ~ 2,000 Middle School students
- Fairfax FSS started in the Fall of 2020
  - ~ 320 names on email list
  - Advocating VDOT infrastructure changes
  - **Traffic regulation changes**
- Northern Virginia FSS is the umbrella organization for all three chapters (AFSS, Arl FSS & Ffx FSS)
  - 501(c)(3) public charity
  - Advocating for traffic law changes in Richmond





#### Our Advocacy with Policy Makers

## NoVA FSS has proactively advocating to General Assembly members in Richmond for the following traffic regulations:

- Hands Free Law
- Vulnerable Road User Law
- Stop at Crosswalk for Pedestrians / All Vulnerable Road Users
- Lower speed limits from 25 mph to 15 mph
- ASE (aka speed cameras) around school & construction zones
  - still advocating for broader implementation



#### Let's make our streets safer for walking and biking!

Have you almost been hit by a driver of a vehicle when walking or cycling? Have you observed a dangerous location where others have almost been crashed into by the driver of a vehicle?

Now, you can report those "near misses" & help make your streets safer!

Just go to the <u>Near Miss / Dangerous Location Survey</u> and report what happened, where it happened and when it happened.


#### NoVA FSS uses the NM data to advocate for:

- Shareable by QR code or hyperlink









## Reported incidents by month




## Reported incidents by time of day




### Near Miss Data - Arlington

Who was impacted by the Near Miss?






## Role of speed




# Drivers are overwhelmingly reported as at fault

#### Number of Incidents by At Fault Activity




# What are people doing when they report a near miss?
